

Unit 1-Letters, sounds and numbers

Lesson 1 - Alphabet

- to introduce and practice the letters of the English alphabet, in order from A to Z
- to provide examples of common nouns that commence with each letter

Lesson 2 - Alphabet

- to introduce and practice the letters of the English alphabet, out of alphabetical sequence
- to provide examples of common nouns that commence with each letter

Lesson 3 - Vowels

Primary objective: • introduce and practice the major vowels

Unit 2-Letters, sounds and numbers

Lesson 1 - Consonants

Primary objective:

•to increase familiarity with common sounds in English with focus on phonemic pair consonants

Lesson 2 - Alphabet

- to commence spelling simple words
- •to provide examples of common nouns that commence with each letter

Lesson 3 - Vowels

Primary objective:

•to introduce and practice the major vowels with a focus on diphthongs (two vowels together)

Unit 3-Letters, sounds and numbers

Lesson 1 - Consonants

Primary objective:

• to increase familiarity with common sounds in English, focus on challenging consonant sounds (e.g. history, yellow) and juxtaposition of often-confused pairs (e.g. map/nap, fat/hat)

Lesson 2 - Numbers

- •to introduce and practice the numbers of zero to twenty
- to provide examples of basic plural nouns (e.g. four cups)

Lesson 3 - Numbers

Primary objective:

• to introduce and practice the numbers of twenty one to one hundred (focus on number twenty one to twenty nine and then thirty, forty, fifty, sixty, seventy, eighty, ninety, one hundred)

Unit 4-Grammar

Lesson 1 - Subject pronouns

Primary objective:

•introduce and practice the subject pronouns

Lesson 2 - Verb to be

Primary objective:

• basic use of the verb to be in present simple tense including the positive and negative tense and use of contractions.

Lesson 3 - A/An with nouns

- •introduce nouns as a person or thing. •use a/an with one person or thing
- •use a/an to say what a person or thing is and for jobs and professions.

Unit 5-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Verb to be

Primary objective:

•to be in question form

•introduction of Who/What/When/Where/Why/How used in questions

Lesson 2 - Present simple

Primary objective:

• present simple positive form with regular verbs and alternate endings (–s, –es and –ies).

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

•practice major parts of the body (head, neck, back, shoulders, knee, legs, elbows, feet)•use those body parts in typical sentences (sore back, hat on head)

Unit 6-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Object pronouns

- •introduce and practice the object pronouns
- review the subject pronouns
- •practice basic prepositions before the object pronouns (to her, at him)

Lesson 2 - Possessive adjectives

Primary objective:

•introduce and practice the possessive adjectives (my, your, his, her, its, our, your, their)

•review the subject and object pronouns

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

•practice of parts of the body, focusing on the face (mouth, ear, nose), mouth (lips, teeth, tongue) and foot (ankle, toes)

Unit 7-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Possessive nouns

- use possessive nouns (Carla's book)
- •use –'s for people (Carla's book)
- •use –'s without a noun (Carla's)
- •use –' for plural nouns that end in -s, or names that end in –s (James' book)
- •use of for things, places, etc. (the name of that town, the top of the hill)
- •use –'s for time words, (yesterday's French lesson, tomorrow's meeting)

Lesson 2 - Present simple

- present simple in negative form
- common present simple irregular verbs (go, do, have)
- •adverbs of frequency (never, sometimes, often, usually, always) + present simple

Unit 8-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

•practice of the parts of the body, focusing on the hand (fingers, thumb, wrist, palm) and hair types and colors

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

•introduction of common food vocabulary (focus on fruit, vegetables, meat, seafood, components of a salad)

Lesson 3 - Prepositions

- •use the prepositions with time: at, on, in
- •introduce fixed expressions with time, like at night, at the moment, in the morning

Unit 9-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

• use of common vocabulary about jobs including where jobs are preformed (e.g. hospital) and what tools are used (e.g. stethoscope)

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

- use of vocabulary around clothing including items of clothing, and parts of clothing (e.g. collar)
- use of adjectives to describe a dress sense (e.g. formal, casual, stylish)

Lesson 3 - Grammar

- •to use this, last, next and every, before which there is no preposition
- •review the prepositions of time: at, on, in

Unit 10-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Vocabulary

- •use vocabulary around immediate family members (siblings, brother, sister, mother, father, daughter, son, wife, husband)
- •introduction of vocabulary around grandparents (grandparents, grandfather, grandchildren, grandson, granddaughter)

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related fruit
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Lesson 3 - Prepositions

- •to introduce the prepositions of time before and after
- •to use (before and after) + verb

Unit 11-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related vegetables
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to meat, delicatessen and small goods.
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- to use the most common vocabulary items related to common pets, including what they eat/how to care for them
- to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 12-Grammar and vocabulary


Lesson 1 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to common farm animals, including what they eat and the agricultural products they produce
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

- to use the most common vocabulary items related to common bugs and insects, including how they can hurt humans (bites/stings) and the products they produce (e.g. honey)
- to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 1-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - To be past simple

- to be in the past simple, positive and negative form
- to be in the past simple, question form (introduction, end of lesson)
- review of to be in the present simple, positive and negative form

Lesson 2 - To be past simple - question forms

- to be in the past simple, question form
- review of to be in the past simple, positive and negative form
- review of question words (Who, What, When, Where, Why, How)
- use of short answers (Yes I was / No I wasn't)

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- •use words to describe weather
- practice of nouns that become adjectives by adding –y (e.g. rain, rainy)
- •use words to describe different temperatures (e.g. freezing, cold, boiling, warm)

Lesson 1 - Subject pronouns

Primary objective:

•use regular and singular and plural forms of nouns (adding -s, -es, -ies, -ves)

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

•practice the names of countries and the distinction between country, nationality and language

Unit 3-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Countable/Uncountable nouns - basics

- to introduce nouns that are always plural (pants)
- •to introduce countable and uncountable nouns
- •to introduce that a/an cannot be used with uncountable nouns

Lesson 2 - Countable/Uncountable nouns

Primary objective:

•to highlight nouns that have both countable and uncountable forms (each with different meanings)

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to the physical aspects of city life
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 4-Grammar

Lesson 1 - Prepositions

Primary objective:

•use the prepositions of place and location: in, at, on

Lesson 2 - Singular/Plural irregular nouns

- •use irregular plural nouns, such as child, man, woman, person, foot, mouse, tooth, dice, etc.
- •use irregular plural nouns that are the same in plural and singular form, such as sheep, deer, moose, fish, shrimp, etc.
- •use the verb to be + adjective

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- •introduce the most common vocabulary items related to sports, hobbies, pastimes and leisure time
- •students will be encouraged to use play, do, gowith the vocabulary

Unit 5-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Prepositions

Primary objective:

•use the prepositions of place and location: in, at, on

Lesson 2 - Nouns and articles

- •use of some in positive sentences and any in negative sentences
- •use of any in most questions, use some in offers and requests

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- •use containers for common nouns (e.g. bowl of rice, bag of apples, carton of milk)
- •express quantities of common nouns (e.g. piece / stack of paper, handful of beans, pile of grains)

Unit 6-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Prepositions

Primary objective:

•to use the prepositions of place and location: in, at, on with the beginning, the middle, the end, the top, the middle, the bottom, etc.

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

•use vocabulary around, aunt, uncle, cousins, nieces, nephews and in-laws

Unit 7-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Prepositions

- •to use the prepositions of place and location:above, below, on, off
- •to use the equivalents of these prepositions: on top of, upon, over, under, underneath, beneath

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

- to use the most common vocabulary items related to fish and seafood
- to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Primary objective:

•to use the prepositions of place and location:between, among, against, by, beside, next to

Lesson 2 - Adjectives

Primary objective:

•introducebasic adjectives by using opposites, focus on simple adjectives (big/small, light/dark, young/old, fast/slow, clean/dirty, easy/difficult, new/old, short/tall, wet/dirty, good/bad, light/dark)

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- to use the most common vocabulary items related to milk and dairy products
- to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 9-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Prepositions

Primary objective:

•to use the prepositions of place and location:across from, opposite, in front of, ahead of, behind

Lesson 2 - Adjectives

Primary objective:

•introduce adjectives by using opposites, focus on some basic, and some less common adjectives(soft/hard, wide/narrow, clever/smart, strong/weak, safe/dangerous)

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to nuts and legumes
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 10-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Prepositions

Primary objective:

•to use the prepositions of place and location: in, inside, within, out of, outside

Lesson 2 - Present continuous

Primary objective:

•use the present continuous in positive form

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to common sea creatures, including fish, mollusks, coral and sea mammals
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 11-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Prepositions

Primary objective:

•to use the prepositions of place and location: near, close, far from, beyond, past

Lesson 2 - Modals

- •use can and can't in positive and negative forms to express ability, possibility and permissions
- use the question form and short answers (common spoken English)

Lesson 3 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to common mammals (primates, rodents, bats, animals with hooves, marsupials etc...)
- •to use the distinction between carnivores and herbivores
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 12-Grammar and vocabulary


Lesson 1 - Modals

- •use could as past tense of can
- •use can for informal polite requests and could for formal polite requests

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to common mammals (turtles, crocodiles, lizards, snakes etc..)
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 1-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Nouns countable/uncountable

- •use some with plural countable nouns and uncountable nouns
- •to contrast a/an and some with countable and uncountable nouns
- •to explain that many uncountable nouns (furniture) have countable parts (chair/desk)

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

Primary objective:

•practice the use of different types of transport including related vocabulary (e.g. get on / get off, airport, train stations, platform)

Primary objective:

- •practice the names of countries and the distinction between continent and region

Lesson 1 - Verbs have and have got

- use have/has in positive form
- use have got/has got (+contractions) as equivalent for have/has

Lesson 2 - Vocabulary

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to the physical aspects of city life
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Unit 4-Grammar and vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Nouns and articles

- •to introduce the pronouns one/ones
- •further practice this/that/these/those

- •to introduce common vocabulary items related to sports, hobbies, pastimes, musical instruments and leisure time
- •to use the verbs play, do, go, collect, make and go to, with the vocabulary

Lesson 1 - Adjectives

Primary objective:

•introduce adjectives by using opposites, focus on intermediate to advanced adjectives(ordinary/unusual, sharp/blunt, bright/dull)

- •to use the most common vocabulary items related to common birds (including nests, eggs, birds of prey and flightless birds)
- •to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Lesson 1 - Nouns and articles

Primary objective:

•to use there is / there are, and there isn't / there aren't with countable / uncountable nouns

- to use the most common vocabulary items related to African safari animals (including habitat features and geography)
- to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language

Lesson 1 - Present continuous

- •the present continuous in negative form
- •the contraction for positive and negative forms

- to use the most common vocabulary items related to Australian Marsupials (including habitat features and geography)
- to use the vocabulary in context and raise awareness about how this vocabulary is used in daily language
